Be vigilant while using the ATM, as there has been a recent increase in card skimming attempts. Below are a few things that can indicate ATM card skimming that can help you protect yourself and your money:

- Loose ATM cover
- Scratches or tape that could be a false ATM front
- A pinhole on the machine where a camera could be installed
- An extra keypad on top of the ATM keypad
- A loose or unstable card reader
